

**DIXON COUNTY AGI SOCIETY March 24, 2014 MEETING**

Treasurer Newton's report was: General Fund Income \$800.68, Expenses \$157.74, Balance \$23,124.88, Savings \$5566.36, Sinking Fund Income \$220.92, Expenses \$none, Balance \$14,776.67, Savings \$10,440.15. Stephanie reported on her attendance at the Zone 5 IFE meeting in Grand Island.

Everything is in place for the District 3 Meeting, April 6<sup>th</sup>. Stephanie will get programs printed. Allan and Tom Schellpeper, District 3 President, are taking RSVPs for the meeting.

Allan had gotten a quote from the Wayne Herald of \$650.00 for printing 3800 copies of the fair book and an additional \$50.00 for some spot color. Stephanie motioned to have the Wayne Herald print the fair books. Sandy 2<sup>nd</sup>. MCU.

Ryan and Allan reported on meeting with the County Board of Supervisors to update them on the beer garden and other things taking place at the fairgrounds.

Allan reported he had met with the County Sheriff and discussed the beer garden. The sheriff said he would talk to the deputies to do the off duty overnight security in 2014 that they had been hired to do in previous years.

Stephanie had contacted Farmers' Pride on the Monday breakfast. They indicated they would do the breakfast but needed the request to go through channels before a definite answer could be given.

Mike reported Delmar and his board approved doing the pulling track and demo pit again this year.
