Don checked on Bull Riding for Saturday night and has a company that can come on that date with all the equipment and animals at a cost of \$6,000 - \$6,500.

Chad from CS Promotions only had Thursday night open. He suggested having a Stock Class, Compact Figure 8 Class, Compact Derby Class and 90s and Newer Derby Class. He also suggested using concrete barriers.

Ryan reported the Outlaws could come on Friday night. The Farm and Antique Pull will start at 11:00. By not having to move the concrete barriers, the track will be ready for the tractor pulls.

Mike reported the Carnival will be here on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday with a minimum of 9 rides, 8 games and inflatables at an estimated cost of \$8,000.00.

The Bleacher company replied that they can furnish the same bleachers as we have been using on the August 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> dates.

The Barbeque will be on Thursday evening.

The Beer Garden will be open Thursday through Sunday.

The Car Show will be on Sunday.

The Open Class Horse Show will be on Sunday.

The Gospel Group will be Sunday evening.

T.J. Walsh motioned to hold the 2018 Fair on August 1<sup>st</sup> through August 5<sup>th</sup>. Cristy 2<sup>nd</sup>. Roll call vote: Aye 7, Nay 0. MCU.
